New adventures await you in painting, drawing, mixed media and the arts in general, no matter if you are young or old, experienced or inexperienced, there is a place for you to explore your creativity at the Art on Target.

Visual art classes are offered by Artists: Bretten-Anne Moolman, Melanie Hillebrand, Cedric Vanderlinden, Estelle Marais and Jonathan Silverman. All the artists are qualified professionals in their fields and have years of experience to share with you. In visual arts we cover: painting, drawing and mixed media, exploring a range of materials and subject matter, which includes: figurative painting, landscape painting, portraiture, figure drawing and much more. Short courses are offered through the course of the year.



Private Studios at Art on Target include: B.A. Moolman's Art Studio. Machela Liefeldt Jewellery and craft studio. Debs de Beer painting Studio and Design on Target: for purpose made items, furniture and other products.

1. Structured Art Enrichment Program for senior school and Post Matric pupils *with B A Moolman and Cedric Vanderlinden*

From beginners to more advanced students wanting extra tuition in art

- Consolidate a sound knowledge of formal art elements, principles and practice.
- Create a strong diverse personal portfolio in different media.
- Prepare Portfolios for compulsory art application to a variety of tertiary institutes.
- Exploration in art practice, visual literacy, and introduction to various visual art disciplines including: drawing, painting, fashion, textile and graphic design and soft sculpture.
- 'Read' and understand artworks through visual literacy and art appreciation.
- Special fee structure and arrangement made for crash course for matric and post matric students needing portfolios for tertiary institutes, please contact me in this regard.

To join the art enrichment program, students need to commit per term. Fees are payable at the beginning of each term or part thereof for late arrivals in the course of a term.

Fees translate to R150 / session all inclusive of materials and tuition.

Classes take place on a Tuesday afternoon 2:30 to 5:30

**Second Term: 18/04 to 30/05 = 7 sessions = R1050

(No class on 9th August, public hols)**

**Fourth Term: 10 /10 to 2/11 = 5 sessions = R750
(Date adjustment due to exams, school term ends 6 /12)**

2. **Informal Adult Art Classes with B A Moolman**

- Grow your understanding of the formal elements and principles of art.
- Drawing, Mixed Media and Painting in a variety of mediums.
- Suitable for beginners who have no experience, intermediate and advanced students.
- New students will use studio equipment for the first month of lessons to familiarize themselves with a variety of mediums, afterwards you will be required to buy a starter kit determined by your preference of medium, lists available on request.

Classes offered on: Monday nights 6 to 9pm or Thursday morning 9 to 12pm

Fee options:

1. Per Month R780/month

It does not matter if you start mid month as the monthly fee translates to 4 lessons and will carry over to the following month. If you miss a lesson however you will only have the opportunity to make that up in the following month and not thereafter.

2. Per Term attending once a week, translates to R170/ session

Term fees are applicable to students who can commit for a whole term.

Payment is due at the beginning of each term.

All payment options include: basic start up material for new students, mineral turpentine, experimental material, paper and standard equipment etc. & tea/coffee

Informal Adult Art First Term = 16/01 to 30/03

Monday night classes: 16/01 ends 27/03 = 11 sessions

Thursday morning classes: 19/01 ends 30/03 = 11 sessions

Informal Adult Art Second Term = 18/04 to 29/06

Monday night classes: 24/04 ends 26/06 = 9 sessions

(Monday night classes cancelled on 1st May, public holidays)

Thursday morning classes: 20/04 ends 29/06 = 10 sessions

(Thursday morn, cancelled 27 April, public holidays)

Informal Adult Art Third Term = 24/07 to 29/09

Monday night classes: 24/07 ends 18/09 = 9 sessions

Thursday morning classes: 27/07 ends 28/09 = 10 sessions

Informal Adult Art Fourth Term = 9/10 to 6 /12

Monday night classes: 9/10 ends 4/12 = 9 sessions

Thursday morning classes: 12/10 ends 30/11 = 8 sessions

3. **Child Art Classes with B A Moolman**(+/- 6 to 12yrs)

- Unleash your child's creativity through weekly art classes.
- Explore art through storytelling and learning the uses of 2D and 3D materials.
- Develop skills in drawing, painting, 3D and mixed media, using real life objects and imagination.
- Also look out for year-round holiday art workshops or book an art workshop for your child's party

Classes take place on Thursday Afternoons 2:30 to 4:30 @ R80 / session all inclusive of materials and a tea/juice break. Fees payable at the beginning of each term.

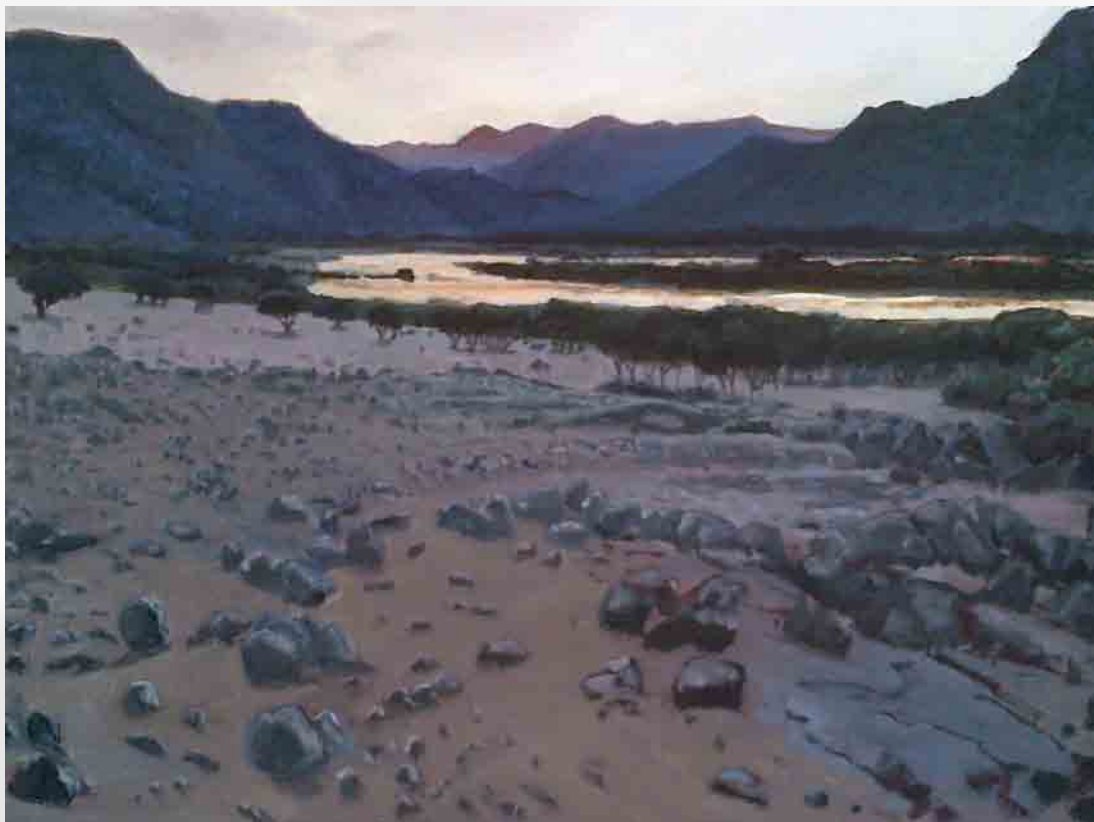

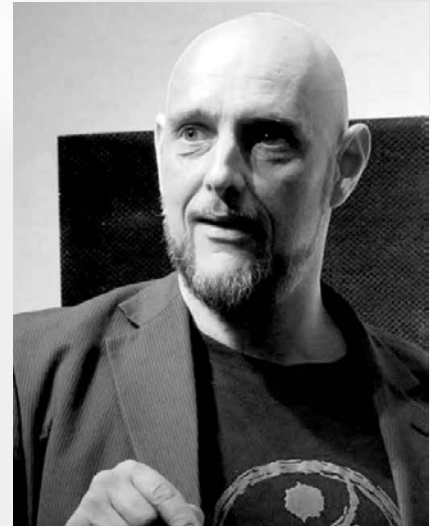
